2016 Roadway Resurfacing Program

PROJECT COMPLETION REPORT

Project:

Included the Paving and Striping of select distressed Township Roadways; Roadway selection is predicated upon a conditional assessment by the Township Engineer and Director of Public Works. All roadways are prioritized based on the ratings assigned and scheduled for resurfacing in accordance with annual funding by the Township Council.

Summary:

The 2016 Road Resurfacing project was completed on October 17, 2016 with the final paving of Seminary Lane. This year the Township installed 3,192.46 tons of asphalt on three (3) Township Roads which equates to 1.79 miles of new pavement. The project was a success with only minor impacts to traffic flow and resident inconvenience while improving rideability, traction control, drainage improvements, and functionality of the paved roadways.
